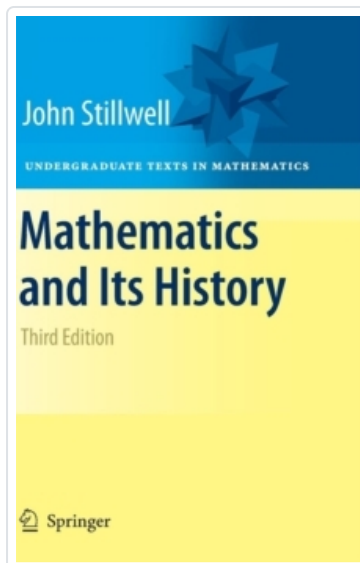


## Mathematics and its History
