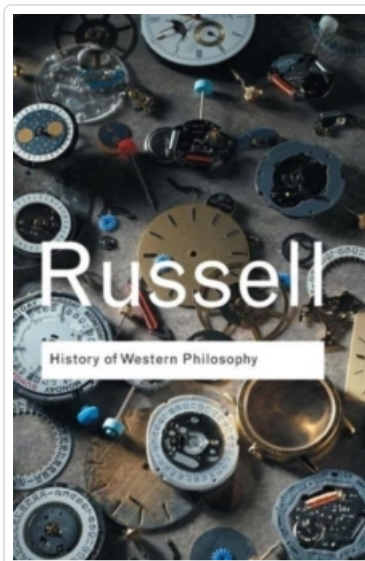


## History of Western Philosophy
