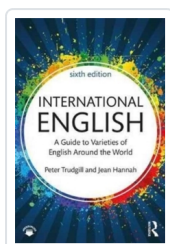
SYNOPSIS

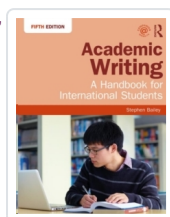

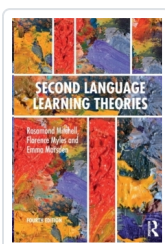

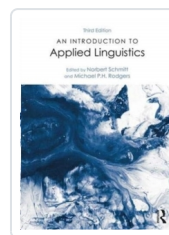
