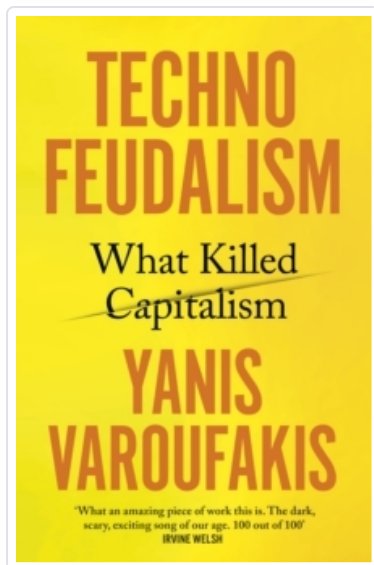


Technofeudalism : What Killed Capitalism
