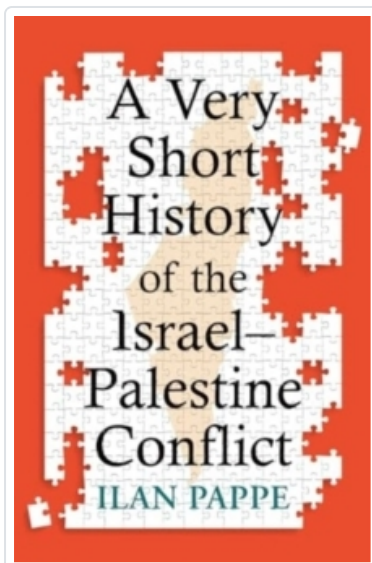


A Very Short History of the Israel–Palestine Conflict
