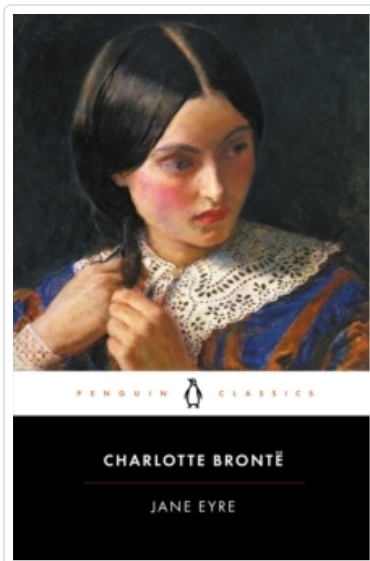


## Jane Eyre
