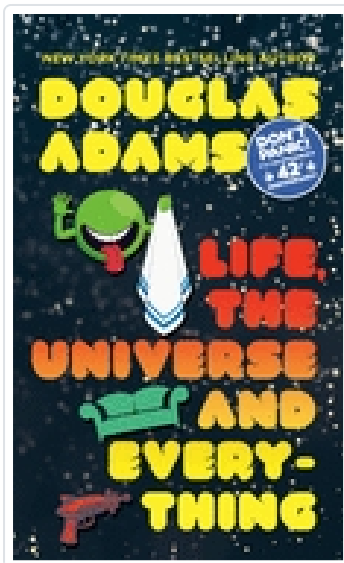


## (03) Life, the Universe and Everything
